Lowell Drive

Redbud (*Cercis canadensis*)
 Serviceberry (*Amelanchier x grandifolia*)
 Japanese tree lilac (*Syringa reticulata*)
DESIGN GOAL: flowering

Robinson Street

Black tupelo (*Nyssa sylvatica*)
 Serviceberry (*Amelanchier x grandifolia*)
DESIGN GOAL: red fall color

Newton Drive

Kentucky coffeetree (*Gymnocladus dioica*)
 Ginkgo (*Ginkgo biloba*)
DESIGN GOAL: yellow fall color; fruitless

Conser Street

Elms (hybrid: *Ulmus* spp. frontier, patriot, princeton, etc...)
 Lacebark elm (*Ulmus parvifolia*)
DESIGN GOAL: umbrella shaped canopy; yellow fall color

72nd Terrace

Oak (*Quercus* spp.; swamp white, white, red, scarlet, chinkapin, etc...)
DESIGN GOAL: Oaks!

This is purely a design suggestion. The goal is for uniformity along the street, but diversity overall in the neighborhood.
