

Things to remember:

- 7 am Friday pickup includes trash, recycling, and yard waste
- Holiday schedule listed on MF website
- Yard Waste
 - Brown bags are only accepted (or bundled sticks)
- Bulky item pickup at GFL now matches OP city ordinance
 - 1 free item pickup a year
 - GFL can no longer accept 1 per quarter
- Contract is for 60-months
 - Pricing increases of 6% annually to be expected

Neighborhood Bulky Item Pickup

Rules and requirements:

- Registration is required for pickup.
- GFL requests description of item.
- Only one bulky item allowed.
- Extra items \$50 each.


Yard of the Month: (May-September + Halloween and Holiday)


